



REA BROOK 10

A Ten Second films project for smartphone

A community submission film project to capture the essence of the Rea Brook Valley.

The final video projection will be created in real time using **autoVID**, a random mode film clip sequencer continuously sequences the clips together to create an endless and continuously changing film.

Guidance on how to take your film:

Filming can be any time of day (or night)

1. Use the built in video app for your smartphone
2. Film in landscape format
3. Keep the camera as still as possible
4. Ideally, there should be some movement in each clip (but it is not essential)
5. The clip should be **no more than 10 seconds**
6. **No editing or cropping**



If you have the **what3words** app on your phone, record the location on the app and add as information in the email.



WHAT3WORDS

We don't want you wasting your mobile data—so don't upload anything until you have Wi-Fi connection.
